1. Complete BOTH parts of the registration form for EACH item entered. Please return by the March 14th regular guild class meeting or mail to Sharon Sutherland, #313 – 885 Forestbrook Dr., Penticton, B.C. V2A 2E9 by the above date. Phone # 250-493-8645

One part will be returned to you with your registration number for each item.

2. Entries must not have been shown in a previous Penticton Quilters' Guild show.
3. Indicate on the entry form the category name and number your item is entered in.
4. The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries accepted. Maximum of 4 per person unless we need more.
5. In the **Artists Statement**, include points such as source of inspiration, construction methods, whether from a kit, pattern designer or original design, etc.

LIMIT COMMENTS TO 50 WORDS OF LESS.

6. Entries **MUST** include a colour 4" x 6" photo of each item entered, with the item taking up as much of the photo space as possible – the item does not have to be finished in the picture. Write your name, name of item, and size of item, W x L, on the back of the photo.
7. Pin a temporary cloth label to the lower right hand corner of the quilt back (as you face the back), with your name, address, phone number and registration number. Put labels for clothing on the inside of the garment. All items to be hung require a sleeve for a dowel. Sleeves must be 4" for items over 48" and 2" for items under 48". Dowel is not required but if you do have one and you would like to use it, please put your name on it and include it in your quilt bag.
8. Each item must arrive in a cloth bag with your name, address, phone number and registration number on the front of the bag. No plastic bags please. Pillow cases usually work.
9. Items for the show must be brought to the Penticton Trade & Convention Centre **Friday, May 4, between 9:00 – 10:00 am.**
10. Your entries will be handled with as much care as possible. Please understand that each quilter is responsible for insuring their own entries.
11. A 20% commission will be collected for all items sold at the show.
12. The show will be open Saturday May 5: 9:30 am – 6:00 pm & Sunday, May 6: 9:30 – 4:00 pm.
13. Items in the show must be picked up between 4:30 and 5:30 pm on Sunday, May 6. You **MUST** present your receipt to collect items. If you are unable to collect your entries yourself, please have a friend pick them up – they must have your receipt to do this.

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PENTICTON QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES

1. ARTISTIC: Must be maker's original design, not from a pattern or someone else's design. It is usually small but can be any size, using any technique/s. May contain mixed medium: e.g. embellished, embroidered, fibre exploration with quilted elements, etc.

2. WALL QUILTS – All Sizes. Quilts that are made to hang on a wall, regardless of size. Wall Quilts may be made using any design or pattern. They can be pieced and/or appliqued by hand or machine. They can be quilted by hand, on a domestic sewing machine or on a long arm machine.

3. MODERN QUILTS – All sizes - Bed or Wall. A brief description of what makes a quilt a Modern Quilt follows: Contains bold colours and prints; increased use of solid fabrics often using gray or white as the neutral; use of re-interpreted traditional blocks or improvisational piecing; embraces simplicity and minimalism with increased use of negative space; focus on finishing quilts on a home sewing machine using linear or geometric quilting designs.

4. TRADITIONAL QUILTS – All Sizes. Sizes from lap to king. Quilts may be made using any design or pattern. They can be pieced and/or appliqued by hand or machine. They can be quilted by hand, on a domestic sewing machine or on a long arm machine.

5. OTHER: WEARABLE ART & NOVELTY ITEMS – Examples: Jackets, Vests, Bags, Accessories, Table Runners, Place Mats, Hats, Pillows, Knick Knacks, etc.
